COVID RATES

Along with this newsletter please find a message from the council that schools have been asked to send out today. You will likely know that COVID rates are high around the borough and many local schools, including Hoylandswaine, have been in outbreak situations at some point this half term. We are all keen to drive down rates as quickly as we can so please do follow this guidance to support this aim.

SQUID GAME

It has come to our attention that some of our children have started playing Squid Game's 'Red Light, Green Light' on the playground. On the surface of it, this is a simple, fun playground game. Squid Game is a Netflix TV programme but can also be watched on YouTube. We are concerned that some of our children may be watching the programme, or accessing clips on YouTube that are not suitable for children.

The programme Squid Game has a high level of violence which is very intense. Characters are tortured and killed for the sadistic pleasure of a game master. Adults have sex and there are threats of sexual violence. Drug use is seen. I'm sure you will agree that none of those topics are suitable for children of primary school age. The games however are based on innocent children's games like marbles and tug of war which is likely to lead to children copying these games when playing and imitating the violence seen in the series. We wouldn't want any of our children to be watching, hearing about or recreating these games in the playground.

We have told the children that these games are banned but would like parents to reinforce this at home. Please also ensure your child is not watching Squid Game on Netflix or YouTube.

As a reminder, online safety is very important in keeping our children safe. It's important to make sure you have parental controls set on all devices your children use. Guides for how to do this can be found by following this link Use Parental Controls to Keep Your Child Safe | NSPCC. National Online Safety have a free app (called the National Online Safety App) which has useful factsheets about all the apps, games, social media platforms etc that your children are able to use. It tells you what they are, any risks/dangers they may pose, how you can support your child to use them safely and how to alter settings.
