## **FUTURE NEWSLETTERS**

Due to the significant financial difficulties we are in at the school, we are in constant contact with the LA to ensure that all measures are being taken to both provide the essentials to the children and to manage the deficit; we are under substantial pressure to make some difficult decisions. We have rejected some of the suggestions made to us at the present time as we feel they will have a detrimental effect on the provision for the children but have had to accept others.

Although we try to keep letters to a minimum putting information on our newsletter each week and texting when possible, the LA still feel our copying budget should be lower. Therefore, after this week, as part of measures to deal with this the newsletter will no longer come home in paper form. Miss Lockwood will continue to put it on the website each week and, from next week, this will be the only place to access this. She will also text parents to let them know the newsletter is on the website to view. We work hard to ensure good communication from school and would ask all parents to be especially systematic about checking the website each weekend so that all information is read and can be acted upon.

On a related finance note, can we please ask parents of children who attend Owls to pay their bills as soon as possible? Our cash flow situation is very unstable and we are very dependent on this money coming into school in the coming week. We would appreciate your support in getting this money into us as soon as possible. Thank you
