### **CROSS LANE**

# **PARKING**

I would like to remind all parents to park considerately of other road users. We have had a number of concerns expressed by parents this week including photos of, what some parents consider to be, inconsiderate parking emailed to me. Some of these photographs do demonstrate parking that is potentially dangerous. Please note:

- Cars should not park opposite the end of Cross Lane as they cause an obstruction
- Cars should not park against the field side of Haigh Lane as they cause an obstruction
- Cars should not park opposite any other vehicle on either Cross Lane or Haigh Lane as this narrows the access too much and causes an obstruction
