ROAD SAFETY

This week our children in class 5 had the opportunity to consider speeding cars as part of their road safety awareness. The children used the speed camera to measure the speed of passing cars and, once the officers had spoken to any speeding drivers, they spoke to the drivers themselves in the hope of encouraging them to consider the dangers of speeding next to a school.
