TOUR DE YORKSHIRE

As many of you know, on 4th May the Tour de Yorkshire will make its way through Penistone. This means that the tour will make its way up Hoylandswaine Hill (A628) between 2.15pm and 2.45pm. Our intention is to take the KS2 children to the roadside with flags and banners to enjoy the atmosphere and experience the event. The information given to us at present indicates that there should be a rolling road block around the race for around 45 minutes before the race gets to us and for a very short time afterwards (dependent on how quickly any crowds disperse). If parents would prefer to collect their children from school at 1.15pm then please do so but we will need them to get their afternoon register mark.
